William Stephen Eddy, D.O., 71, was born on January 7, 1952 to Clyde and Louise Eddy and passed away on December 8, 2023. Stephen was the youngest of eight siblings. He attended the University of Tulsa as an undergraduate biology major. Dr. Eddy began his professional medical career after receiving his doctoral in Osteopathic Medicine in 1981 from Oklahoma State University. He subsequently received in 2001 the Master of Public Health degree from the University of Oklahoma. Dr. Eddy began his medical career as a general practitioner in his private practice. In 1984, Dr. Eddy joined the faculty at the OSU College of Osteopathic Medicine as a professor of Family Medicine.
