

James Edmund Halligan

Dr. James E. Halligan, 86, was born on June 23, 1936, in Moorland, IA, to Raymond and Ann (Crawford) Halligan and passed away on October 25, 2022, in Oklahoma City, OK. He graduated from Moorland High School in 1954 and later enlisted in the US Air Force, attaining the rank of Staff Sergeant. Jim and Ann Sorenson were married on June 29, 1957.
